



A BRIDGE TO NORMAL - Guidelines for In-person Worship

1. All are welcome!
2. If you are vaccinated, you may choose to not wear a mask. If you are not vaccinated, we ask that you wear a mask.
3. Chairs will be set in rows 6 feet apart to allow social distancing.
4. Once you enter the sanctuary, we ask that you choose your seat(s). When greeting one another, please do so with a wave or a “Hello”, saving handshakes and hugs for outdoors.
5. Feel free to socialize outside and enjoy our surroundings.
6. Front and both side doors of the sanctuary will remain open for the duration of the service to allow for cross-ventilation.
7. The order of the liturgy will be similar to the current Outdoor Worship in order to keep indoor time less than 45 minutes.
8. Congregational prayer and spoken responses are allowed.
9. Singing is not yet considered safe for group settings, so there will be no congregational hymn singing. There will be a song leader (cantor) who may sing solo or in a small ensemble behind the piano, maintaining a 15-foot distance from the assembly.
10. Pastor will lead service from the chancel (top of the steps) and preach without a mask.
11. A reader may come to the front to read without a mask.
12. Ushers will dismiss worshipers by rows to enable social distancing between families while indoors, and communion will be served by row via single file down the center isle with social distancing.
13. Offering plate will be set at the baptismal font, for deposit as worshipers enter or exit worship.
14. Worship schedule will continue as per Outdoor Worship: 1st, 3rd, 5th Sundays 11:00am, 2nd and 4th Saturdays, 5:00pm. This will be re-evaluated monthly and adjusted as needed.
15. Online Worship Webcast will continue to be produced and posted weekly.
